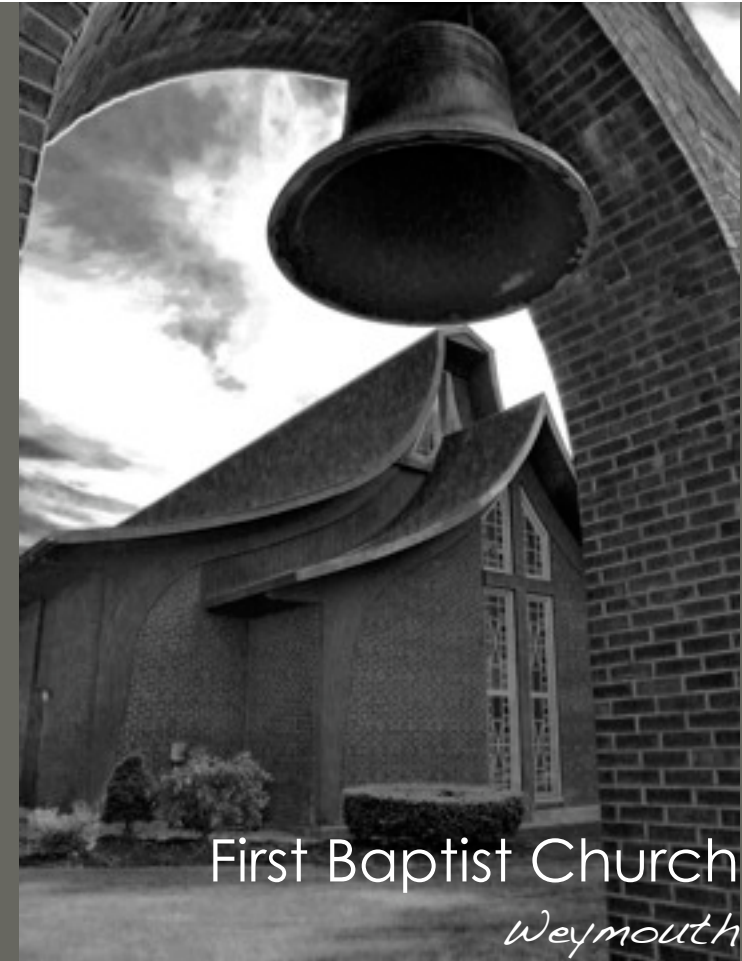

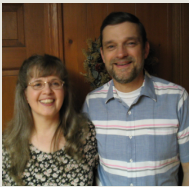

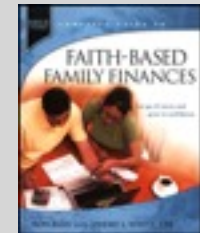
Passage: Gen. 22: 1-19, Heb. 11:17-19
